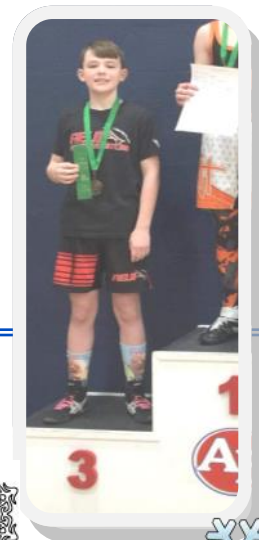
FIELD YOUTH ATHLETICS

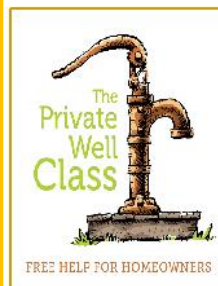
