- All buildings will be closed to all non-school groups or teams after 4:30pm and on weekends. (This includes all indoor youth sports activities).

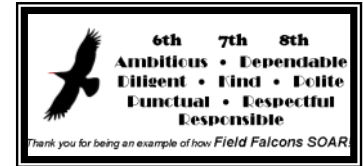
These reductions will drastically affect student academic opportunities in this district and will interfere with the efficient operation and the effective maintenance of our buildings and grounds.
