
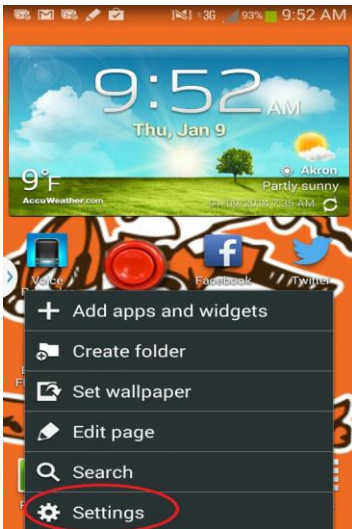


## GETTING THE MAC ADDRESS ON ANDROID DEVICES

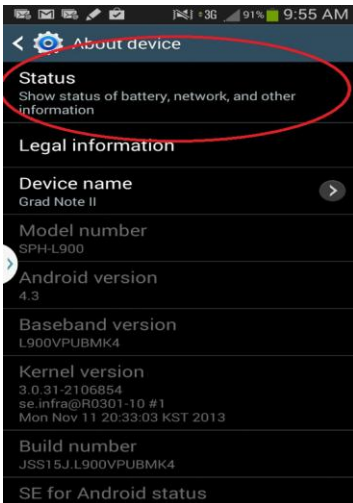
1. Unlock your device.
2. Press the  button and select “settings”.



3. Select “About Device”



4. Select “status”. This will take you to the status screen.



5. In the “status” screen, scroll until you find “Wi-Fi MAC address”. The address listed here will be your device’s MAC address (it should be in the XX:XX:XX:XX:XX:XX format). Please send me this address, but do not include the colons in between the letters/numbers (for the purpose of speeding up the process and allowing me to simply copy and paste, I need the address to be 1a2b3c4d5e6f rather than 1a:2b:3c:4d:5e:6f).
