

DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Monitoring requirements not met for Central Elementary School

We are required to monitor your drinking water for corrosion control indicators. During the July – December 2021 monitoring period, Central Elementary School failed to collect water quality parameter samples at the correct frequency required by Ohio EPA.

What Should I Do?

This notice is to inform you that Central Elementary School did not monitor and/or report results for corrosion control indicators as required by Ohio EPA during the July – December 2021 monitoring period. You do not need to take any actions in response to this notice.

What Is Being Done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above-mentioned parameters, which they have done. Central Elementary School will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.
