School Bus Safety Rules:

1. Students shall arrive at the bus stop **5-8 minutes** before the bus is scheduled to arrive.
2. Students must wait in a location clear of traffic and away from the bus stop at the “designated point of safety”.
3. Behavior at the school bus stop must not threaten life, limb or property of any individual.
4. Students must go directly to their **assigned seat**, so the bus may safely resume motion.
5. Students must remain seated, keeping aisles and exits clear.
6. Students must observe classroom conduct rules and obey the driver promptly and respectfully
7. Students may not use any verbal or physical threats to bully other students on the bus.
8. Students must not use profane language.
9. No eating and/or drinking on the bus except as required for medical reasons.

School Bus Safety Rules Continued:

10. No tobacco, drugs, or alcohol should be in the possession of anyone on the school bus unless it is a medication given for a life threatening condition (bee sting kit, asthmatic inhaler, epi pen, etc.) Prescriptions must be taken to the child's school building by the parent with proper instructions from the physician.
11. Students must not have alcohol and drugs in their possession on the bus except for prescription medication required for a student.
12. Students must not throw or pass objects on, from, or into the bus.
13. Students may carry on the bus only objects that can be held in their laps.
14. No animals of any type are allowed on the bus (this includes insects in glass jars.)
15. Students must leave or board the bus at locations to which they have been assigned unless they have parental, administrative, and/or transportation office authorization to do otherwise.
16. Students must not put their head or arms out of the bus windows.
17. Students and their parents will be responsible for payment to fix or replace any vandalism a student may cause.
