

Class 2023 and Beyond

The State has defined a Permanent Graduation Pathway for the Class of 2023 and beyond. This pathway still requires students to obtain Field High School's required 21-credits to graduate and asks students to show competency and readiness.

State Requirement, Show Competency- Pass the Ohio State Tests

Earn a competent score on Ohio's high school English II, Algebra, and Geometry tests. **Geometry is still under consideration for removal; the test will be administered until further guidance is provided by ODE. If testing is not the student's strength, students who do not pass the test(s) will be offered additional support and must retake the test(s) at least once. After he/she has retaken the test(s), there are 3 additional ways to show competency!

State Requirement, Option 1 – Demonstrate Two Career Focused Activities

Students need to choose two Career Focused Activities from the list below- once of which needs to be a Foundational Skill.

Career Focused Activities

| Foundational Skill | Supporting Skill |

State Requirement, Option 2 – Enlist in the Military

Students can show competency by enlisting in the military- a signed contract to enter a branch of the U.S. armed services upon graduation is required.

State Requirement, Option 3 –Complete College Coursework

Earn credit for one college-level math and/or college-level English course through Ohio's free College Credit Plus program.

State Requirement, Show Readiness-Earn Seals

Earn two of the following diploma seals, choosing those that line up with your goals and interests. These seals give you the chance to demonstrate academic, technical, and professional skills and knowledge that align to your passions, interests, and planned next steps after high school.

At least one of the two must be Ohio-designed



OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal*

Students must have 3 mentors in two of the following 3 environments: school, work, and/or community to validate the 15 professional skills



Industry-Recognized Credential Seal*

This seal is earned when a license in one of the following “in-demand” professions is acquired through Maplewood: Auto Collision Technology, Automotive Service Excellence, Cosmetology, Dental Assisting, Machining, and Welding



College-Ready Seal*

Earn remediation-free scores on the ACT or SAT: 22 on English and mathematics



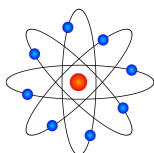
Military Enlistment Seal*

Providing evidence of enlistment in an armed services branch of the military; OR participating in an approved Junior Reserve Officer Training (JROTC) program



Citizenship Seal*

Proficient on American History and American Government End Of Course exam; Advanced Placement credit; earn a “B” or higher in approved College Credit Plus Courses



Science Seal*

Proficient on the Biology End Of Course exam; Advanced Placement credit; earn a “B” or higher in approved College Credit Plus Courses



Honors Diploma Seal*

Meet the criteria for one of 5 honors diplomas:

- Honors Diploma
- Career-Tech Honors Diploma
- STEM Honors Diploma
- Civics and Social Sciences
- Fine Arts Honors Diploma



Seal of Biliteracy*

Attain a score of 5 on the AAPPL: an assessment of standards-based language learning across the three modes of communication: Interpersonal, Presentational, and Interpretive



Technology Seal*

Advanced Placement credit; earn a “B” or higher in an approved College Credit Plus course; or complete a course offered through the student’s school that meets guidelines set by the ODE



Community Service Seal**

Following the guidelines adopted by Field Local’s School Board, complete 80 hours of community service or a Passion Project



Fine and Performing Arts Seal**

Following the guidelines adopted by Field Local’s School Board, athletes, marching band and club members, and Passion Project participants are eligible to obtain this seal



Student Engagement Seal**

Following the guidelines adopted by Field Local’s School Board, demonstrate skills in the fine or performing arts in drama, course work, achievement or a Passion Project
